To enhance the communication and presentation skills, Board of Studies of ICAI is going to organize “National Talent Hunt” for the CA Students which will be held on Tuesday, 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 at 4 PM at the Institute’s Premises (ICAI Bhawan, Plot No- A/122/1, Nayapalli, Bhubaneswar-7 ) List of topics are given hereunder :

**TOPICS FOR NATIONAL TALENT HUNT 2017**

1. Public Private partnership (PPP) : A solution to Many problems.
2. Effects of Replacement of textbooks with I pads or elearning Modules.
3. Ways of improving India’s Rank in Ease of Doing Business.
4. Importance of independence of Auditor.

The contestant can choose any topic (s)\* from the list but while choosing the topic, they need to bear in mind that they are thorough in that topic as they will be cross questioned to which they should be able to answer.

Students registered with the Institute for Final Course undergoing articles/audit training, Intermediate (IPC) Course are eligible to participate in the contest. Thus, students who have completed articles/audit training are not eligible to participate. The contestants may be permitted to express their views for a maximum period of 12 minutes depending on the number of participants on any of the selected topics. The medium of competition will be English. Two winners at the Branch level will be allowed at the second stage and face the contest at Regional level which should be completed by 10<sup>th</sup> June. Four winners from each Region will be the final contestants at the National Talent Hunt scheduled on 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 at New Delhi.

The 1<sup>st</sup> three winners of National Hunt would be awarded the cash prizes of Rs. 31,000/-, Rs. 21,000/- and Rs. 11,000/- respectively. First two winners will, thereafter, participate in SAFA Elocution Contest/International Conference of ICAI.

Students willing to participate should contact Branch office on or before 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 and to apply in writing. There may be screening round to be conducted before 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2017.
