The focus is gradually shifting from:

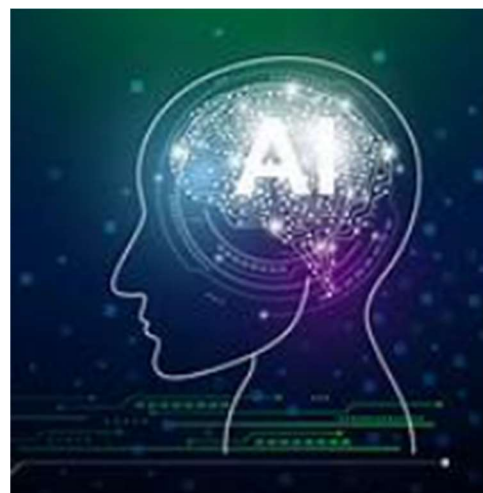
“Reactive Compliance”

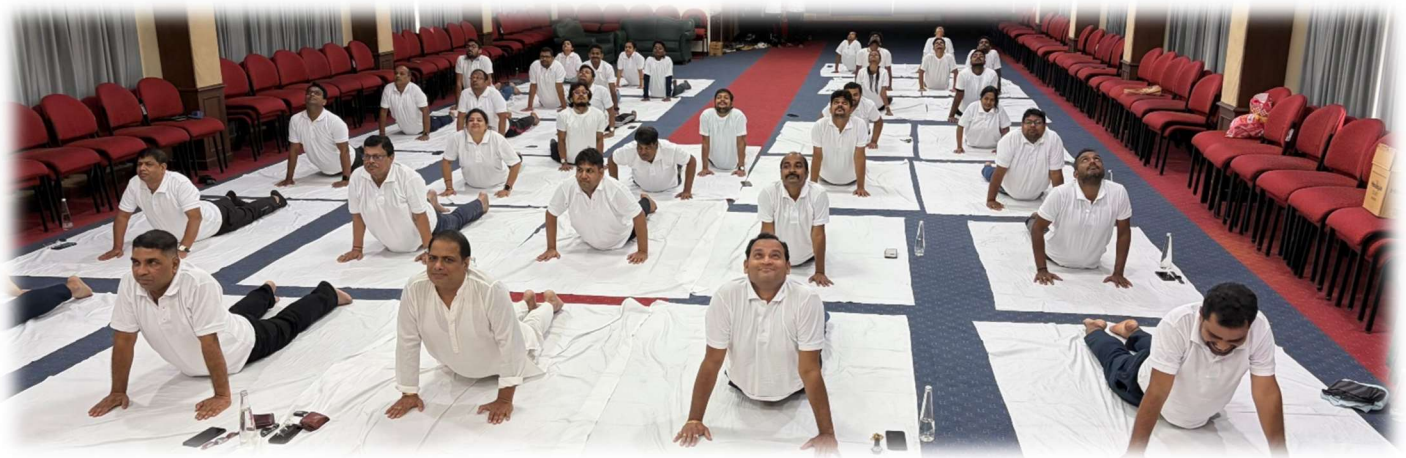
